

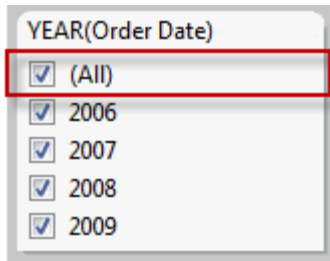
Customize Quick Filters

When preparing a workbook to share with others you may want to customize which quick filter options are shown. For example, you may want to hide the “(All)” option available in a multiple value list. In addition to the All option, you can hide or show the Search, Include/Exclude, Filter Types, More/Fewer button, and more. Customizing quick filters is particularly useful when you are sharing views with Tableau Reader and Tableau Server.

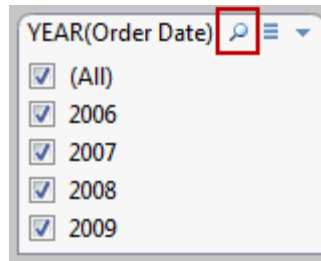
Open the Quick Filter menu and Select Customize

Open the quick filter menu (arrow in the upper right corner of the quick filter card). Then select an option on the **Customize** sub-menu. The options toggle between hiding and showing the following quick filter commands.

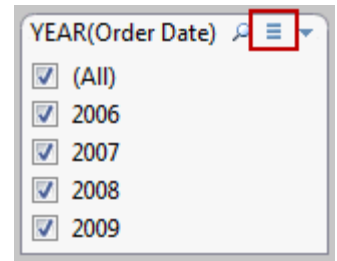
Show “All” Value



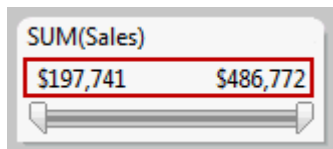
Show Search Button



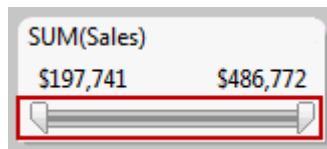
Show More/Fewer Button



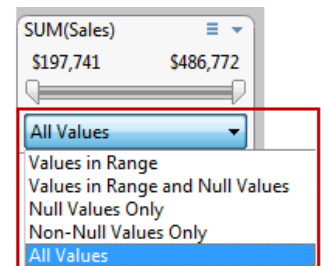
Show Readouts



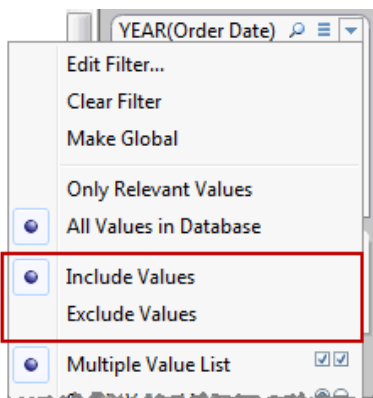
Show Slider
