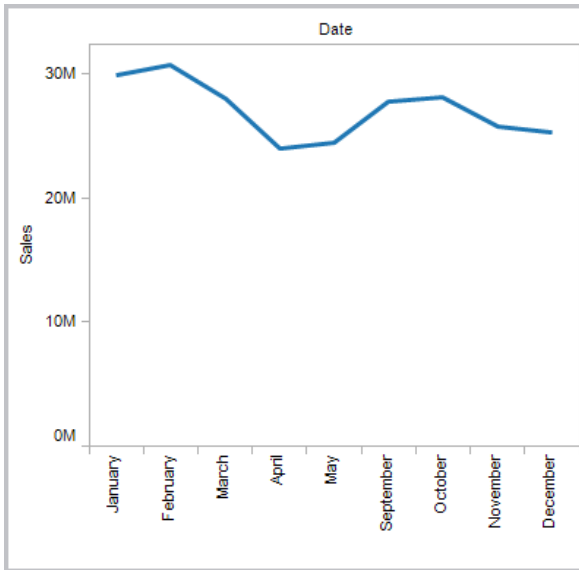


# Show Missing Values

When working with dates or numeric bins, there may be times when your data doesn't contain the full range of values. For example, it may contain data for January - May and September - December but there was no data recorded for June, July, and August. If you create a line chart in Tableau, the missing months will not be shown. You can optionally show the missing months to make it clear that there was no data recorded during that time.

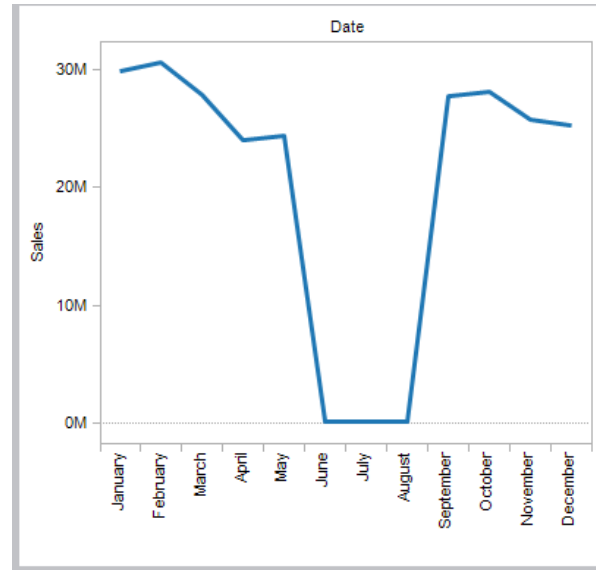
### Missing Values are Hidden

By default, missing values in a date range or numeric bins are now shown.



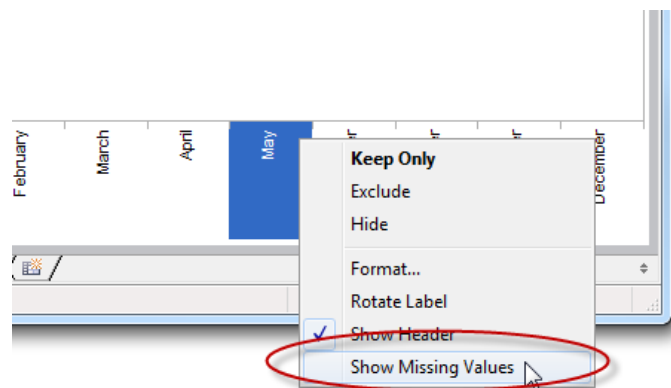
### Missing Values are Shown

You can optionally, show the missing values so that the complete range is shown.



## Show Missing Values

Right-click the date or bin headers and select **Show Missing Values**.



**Note:** You can show missing values for all categorical date field (e.g., Year, Quarter, Month, Day, etc.). You can also show missing values for binned measures. When shown, the missing values will be considered when computing table calculations.
