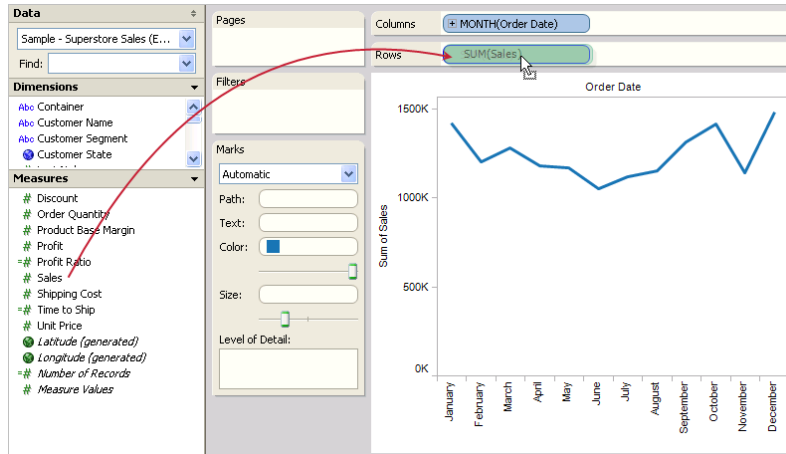


# Secondary Axes

In addition to blending multiple measures on the same axis, you can add a second axis to a view so that you can better compare measures of different scales.

## 1 Drag a Measure to the View

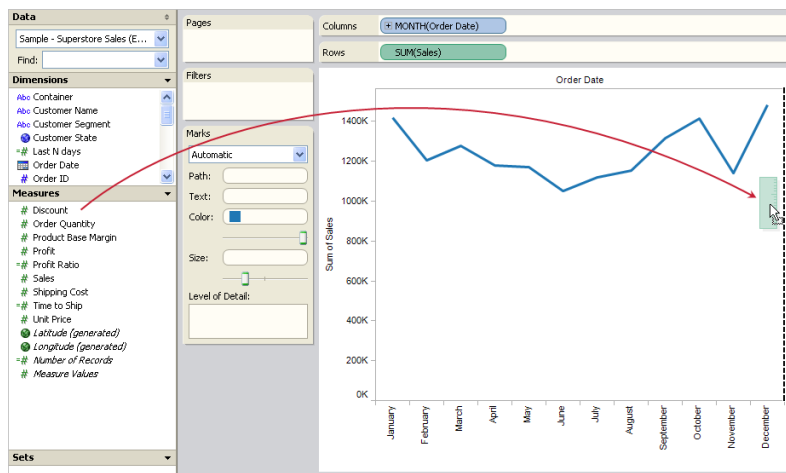
Drag a continuous field from the Data window to the view.



When you add a measure or continuous field to the view an axis is created.

## 2 Add a Second Measure to the View

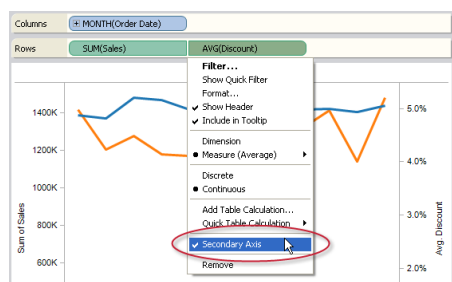
Drag a second measure to the view but this time drag it to the far right side of the view. A dashed line and a ruler icon will display when you hover over the right side of the view.



You can instead add another measure to the view and then click the **Show Me!** button on the toolbar.

## 3 Remove the Secondary Axis

At anytime you can remove a secondary axis by selecting **Secondary Axis** on the field menu.



You can edit each axis individually by right-clicking one of the axes and selecting **Edit**. There you can specify the scale, tick marks, title, and more.
